Thank you for contacting the National Personnel Records Center. We are providing the releasable military service information based on restrictions imposed by the military services consistent with Department of Defense regulations and the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act and the Privacy Act of 1974. - Funeral director's signed statement of death
- Verdict of coroner's jury
- If death occurred outside the United States, any document similar to one of the preceding five, or a report of death signed by a United States consul or other agent of the State Department.

We also suggest you contact the California Adjutant General in which they have a US Army National Guard File on the veteran above.

National Guard records are normally maintained by the military service or the Adjutant General's Office in the state in which service was performed. Occasionally, portions of these records are transferred to our Center for permanent storage, and we have located such a record in our holdings. A thorough search of that record revealed documents partially responsive to your request and those documents are enclosed. We suggest that you contact the appropriate office listed below for further assistance in locating the desired records.
